PRESENT AROUND THE WORLD

Present around the World (PATW) is IET's premium presentation competition for Engineering Students, Apprentices and Young Professionals. The regional level (IET Pakistan Network) of PATW is going to be held on 16th June 2010 in UET Lahore, Pakistan.

Prize:

- The prize is **£150** for the winner plus IET UK Certificate.
- The winner will also receive **one year's free membership** of the IET.
- The Winner will avail **50% discount** on all of the IET UET CHAPTER's exciting array of coming events for a year!
- The winner may also qualify for later stages of the worldwide competition, which offer greater prize money (upto £1000) and the opportunity to travel around the world.

Rules for participation:

Who can participate:

- All Engineering disciplines
- All sessions (undergrads)
- M.Sc students
- The participation isn't in the form of group rather only an individual will have to deliver the presentation. However, the presenter can employ his/her colleagues to manipulate the visual aids (multimedia projector slides).
- Total of 10 participants will compete in this competition

Steps for Registration:

- A priori online registration at uet.theiet.org.pk
- Submission of synopsis (1000 words) during online registration. Its reiterated that initial selection of candidates will be primarily done on the basis of content of submitted synopsis.
- This online registration is free of charge.
- Online Registration deadline is June 13, 2010
- After the approval of synopsis from senior faculty advisers, only the short-listed successful candidates will be notified (via telephony and email) of their confirmed appearance in the competition.
- The shortlisted candidates will have to submit the nominal dues (Rs. 500/-) upon their arrival to UET Lahore on the day of competition

Topic:

Any Engineering or technology related to your discipline. Final year students can also deliver their Project presentations.

Presentation Round:

The competitors will be judged primarily on the basis of their presentation skills. Each contestant will be allowed 10 minutes to present his/her presentation which will immediately be followed by a 10 minutes tough question/answer session.

During each presentation, the Chair of the Judge panel will indicate the time after 8 minutes and then again after 10 minutes. The speaker should then finish the presentation as quickly as possible. If necessary, the Chair will interrupt the speaker and ask them to stop immediately.

The contestants will be judged 75 percent on the basis of their presentation skills and 25 percent on the content of their presentation. This allows young engineers at different level of education or career to be judged on equal footings.

Registration:

500 PKR/- (Non-refundable, will be submitted on the day of competition upon arrival to the campus)

Registration Deadline:

- 12:00 am, 13th June, 2010 (free online a priori registration)
- 12:00 pm, 15th June 2010 (registration for the final round after confirmation from the IET UET CHAPTER)

Visual Aids:

Equipments (Visual Aids like Multimedia Projector, Sound-system, Laser-pointer) for delivering presentations will be provided but precise requirements should be discussed with the event organizer (IET UET CHAPTER).

Judge Panel:

The Judge panel will comprise of senior members of IET Pakistan & YPS, UET Senior Faculty, Industry personnel and Director KICS, UET Lahore.
